

Is EIT InnoEnergy the only Beneficiary of this grant subject to CFS? Or will there be more Beneficiaries/Subgrantees subject to the CFS?

EIT InnoEnergy is the only Beneficiary of this grant and the sole purpose of this CFS

What are the main cost categories and are they claimed on actual costs, unit costs or flat rates? What are the expected number of items per cost category?

Main cost categories are A. Personnel, B. Subcontracting; and C1. Travel and C3. OGS; with limited amounts for C2 and D. Costs are claimed as actual costs. For Personnel, sample population would around 30 based on the number of employees for the period. For Subcontracting, sample population would be around 30 based on vendor. For Travel, there will be over 3K entries for a sample size above 300 items. For OGS, sample population would be above 100 based on vendor. *For travel costs, according to the grant agreement, we need to report as unit costs. We are asking for more details, and an update will be provided

For unit costs, are these the usual practice of the Beneficiary or the unit cost is defined by the Grant Agreement? Costs claimed based on unit costs defined by the Grant Agreements are not subject to the AuPs shared.

As mentioned above, the unit costs are being studying to see how to proceed

Do you envision that the full fieldwork will be done on site or just the closing meeting? Also will the fieldwork be done from Eindhoven (the Netherlands) or it can be done from the Brussels office?

Only the closing meeting will be done on-site. The fieldwork can be done by any of the offices.
